

GRB Academy Softball Head & Assistant Coach Positions

About GRB Academy

Created from small group sessions and camps in gyms across Wisconsin, the GRB Academy and the Rays baseball and softball programs have grown into one of the top places to train and play in the Midwest.

Beginning as far back as the winter of 2005, the GRB Academy started with the training of Greg Reinhard in small gyms spread out in several cities. After running the training and practices of several organizations in Wisconsin, in addition to the camps across Wisconsin, GRB found its home in Madison with the opening of the first facility in December of 2011.

Since opening its doors in 2011, GRB has proven itself as one of the leaders in amateur baseball in Wisconsin.

The Rays program first launched in June of 2009. Since that time, it has grown and expanded and become one of the most coveted programs to play for in the Midwest. With its rapid ascension to the top of amateur baseball, the Rays and GRB were ranked 39th in the country in 2015 by Perfect Game. In total, the Rays have put out 175 college players, 90 of them to scholarship schools, and six draft picks as of September of 2015.

With the opening of the new GRB Academy in 2017, GRB launched its Softball Program. Its inaugural year hosted four teams and placed four players into college softball. With this success, the softball program has doubled in size, with eight teams from 10U-18U.

The mission is simple yet clear: “The Mission of the GRB Academy and Rays program is to advance the skill sets of baseball and softball players by providing them with the best trainers and up to date, innovative training methods.”

The motto of GRB from the beginning: “Baseball and Softball for the Serious Player”

Job Description

GRB Academy has a need for Head and Assistant Softball coaches for the 2018 Summer Season at its 10U, 12U, 14U, 16U and 18U age levels. The 2018 season includes weekend tournament play in June and July. Number of weekends played is dependent on age level, you can expect to play most if not all weekends during this time frame. Coaches are expected to travel and attend all tournaments on the team’s schedule. Additionally, they will attend and manage 1-2 practices per week at GRB Academy.

Experience

Essential

- Previous softball experience at a high school level minimum

Desirable

- Minimum of 1 year softball coaching experience in a paid or voluntary capacity, ideally at a high school or college level

- Demonstrate strong leadership qualities and have the ability to delegate effectively
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Strong planning ability with excellent organizational skills
- Ability and willingness to work outside of normal hours, including evening and weekends
- Must be self-motivated with the ability to enthuse a wide range of personalities
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Ability to manage group of participants effectively
- Attend all tournament/practice sessions
- Solution oriented
- Resilient with a can do attitude
- Sound understanding of club, high school and college softball

Compensation

The Head Coach is a paid position.

The Assistant Coach is a volunteer position, which can be used for school credit.

Both positions receive mileage reimbursement, food stipend, and lodging accommodations paid by GRB Academy.
